Wine-making has a very long traditions in Armenia. According to the numerous evidences people had grown grape and made wine here since 15th century BC.

Brandy is one of the best-known Armenian brands. Armenian brandy production was established in 1887 in Yerevan by merchant and philanthropist Nerses Tairyan. Among the people who have made the famous Armenian brandy were Mkrtych Mousinyants and Margar Sedrakyan.
